It is from this list that the NARAS members cast their votes, and the top vote-getters are derived. Votes are to be based on quality, as opposed to sales chart performance, friendships or other alliances.

The Coso sisters are extremely honored to be recognized for this musical achievement and accolades after singing together since they were children. In addition to performing locally, they also performed and directed The Patriot Tour (USO), and sung in venues from Balboa Park in San Diego to Camp Lejeune, NC.
